Journey Through the Holy Land

January 11–20, 2027

A Life-Changing Biblical Experience

Day 1 – Monday, January 11 - Departure

Depart on overnight transatlantic flights to **Tel Aviv**. Sit back and relax as meals are served onboard and anticipation builds for your journey to the Holy Land.

Day 2 – Tuesday, January 12

Arrival in Israel | Jaffa | Mediterranean Coast

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport and receive a warm welcome to Israel. Begin your journey with a walking tour of **Old Jaffa**, one of the world's most ancient port cities, rich with biblical and historical significance. Continue north along the Mediterranean coast to Netanya. **Dinner and overnight:** Herzliya / Netanya

Day 3 – Wednesday, January 13

Caesarea | Mount Carmel | Megiddo | Nazareth

Explore **Caesarea Maritima**, the Roman port city built by Herod the Great. Travel to **Mount Carmel**, then on to **Megiddo (Armageddon)**, overlooking the Valley of Jezreel. Visit **Nazareth**, Jesus' hometown, and reflect from **Mount Precipice**. **Dinner and overnight:** Tiberias (Sea of Galilee)

Day 4 – Thursday, January 14

Sea of Galilee Ministry Sites

Experience the heart of Jesus' Galilean ministry. Visit **Magdala** and its first-century synagogue, **Capernaum**, **Tabgha** (the site of the feeding of the 5,000), and the region of the **Gadarenes**. Ascend the **Mount of Beatitudes**, where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. If time permits, visit **new Bethsaida**. **Dinner and overnight:** Tiberias

Day 5 – Friday, January 15

Boat Ride | Northern Israel | Golan Heights

Visit **Kibbutz Ginnosar** to see the ancient "Jesus Boat," followed by a memorable **boat ride on the Sea of Galilee**. Continue to **Tel Dan**, **Caesarea Philippi**, and enjoy panoramic views from **Mount Bental** in the Golan Heights. **Dinner and overnight:** Tiberias

Day 6 – Saturday, January 16

Jordan Valley | Baptism Site | Dead Sea

Travel south through the Jordan Valley. Visit **Beit She'an** and **Ein Harod**, then continue to **Jericho**, one of the world's oldest cities. Stop at **Qasr el-Yahud**, the traditional baptism site on the Jordan River, with an **optional opportunity for baptism**. End the day floating in the **Dead Sea** before ascending to Jerusalem. **Dinner and overnight:** Jerusalem

Day 7 – Sunday, January 17

Jerusalem – Old City & Bethlehem

Enter the Old City of Jerusalem to explore **Mount Moriah / Temple Mount**, the **Pools of Bethesda**, and the **City of David**. Walk through the **Western Wall Tunnels** and continue to **Bethlehem**, birthplace of Jesus. **Dinner and overnight:** Jerusalem

Day 8 – Monday, January 18

Mount of Olives | Passion Sites

Begin the day on the **Mount of Olives**, then walk the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Visit the **Upper Room**, the **House of Caiaphas**, and the **Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu**. Conclude the day at **Golgotha** and the **Garden Tomb**, reflecting on Christ's sacrifice and resurrection. **Dinner and overnight:** Jerusalem

Day 9 – Tuesday, January 19

Masada | Dead Sea Region | Jerusalem Views

Travel to the dramatic fortress of **Masada**, then visit **Ein Gedi** and **Qumran**, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Return to Jerusalem with a panoramic view from **Mount Scopus**. **Dinner and overnight:** Jerusalem

Day 10 – Wednesday, January 20

Return Home

Transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for your return flight home, carrying unforgettable memories and a deeper understanding of Scripture.

Terms and Conditions

Passport - A passport is required to board an international flight and travel to Israel. If you do not have a current passport, please make an appointment with the postal service and allow 10 weeks after your appointment to complete the renewal process in the US. Passports must be valid until July 21, 2027 for this tour.

Travel Insurance is HIGHLY recommended for international travel. For best coverage, purchase your travel insurance within 2 weeks of booking your tour. Compare travel insurance options at this website: TravelInsurance.com

Deposits and Payments - A deposit of \$500 is required from each traveler, along with your reservation form, to guarantee your space on the tour. The remaining balance is due in 2 payments.

1. Airfare Payment is due upon ticketing the flight.
2. Final Payment is due 11/1/26. See Terms and Conditions for late payment penalties.
3. A supplement for single occupancy must be paid in full with the final payment.

Activity Levels

This Tour has an Activity Level Rating of 3-4.

3- Moderate - Moderate tours accommodate guests who are moderately fit, and are comfortable participating in long days of activity. Some physical exertion is expected.

4- Active tours are appropriate for guests who are physically fit, expect a vigorous pace and longer tour days, including walking tours of up to 4 hours without a rest period on the motorcoach.

Health and Mobility Challenges

Tours in Israel include areas that have uneven footing, few handrails, rocky pathways, and some steep climbs. The streets and sites we visit are not wheelchair and walker friendly. Most of our tours include 3-5 miles of walking per day. Guests with mobility challenges or other health issues should make private arrangements to travel with a caregiver who can stay with them if they need to opt out of a tour stop. Bus drivers are allowed breaks, and guests cannot be left alone on the bus if the bus is locked and unattended. If you have health challenges, please consult an Aliyah Tours representative before you put down a deposit on a tour.
