October 24 – November 3, 2027

Join us for an unforgettable 11-day journey through Israel—where Scripture comes to life, history unfolds before your eyes, and faith is strengthened through meaningful encounters in the Land of the Bible.

Day 1 – Sunday, October 24, 2027

Overnight Flight to Tel Aviv

Depart on your trans-Atlantic flight to Israel. Enjoy in-flight meals and prepare your heart for the journey ahead.

Day 2 – Monday, October 25, 2027

Welcome to Israel – Jaffa – Netanya

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport. Travel to ancient Jaffa, one of the oldest port cities in the world, for a walking tour through its charming alleyways and biblical history. Continue north along the Mediterranean coast to your hotel in Herzliya/Netanya.. Dinner and overnight: Herzliya/Netanya

Day 3 – Tuesday, October 26, 2027

Caesarea – Mount Carmel – Megiddo – Nazareth

Explore the impressive Roman ruins of Caesarea Maritime. Stand atop Mount Carmel, where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Visit Megiddo (Armageddon) overlooking the Jezreel Valley. Continue to Nazareth and Mount Precipice for a panoramic view of the Galilee region. Dinner and overnight: Tiberias

Day 4 – Wednesday, October 27, 2027

Sea of Galilee Ministry Sites

Experience a powerful day around the Sea of Galilee. Visit Magdala and its first-century synagogue, Capernaum, Tabgha, the Mount of Beatitudes, and the region of the Gadarenes. If time permits, visit new Bethsaida. Dinner and overnight: Tiberias

Day 5 – Thursday, October 28, 2027

Ancient Boat – Tel Dan – Caesarea Philippi – Golan Heights

Visit Kibbutz Ginossar to see the preserved first-century “Jesus Boat,” followed by a peaceful boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Travel north to Tel Dan and Caesarea Philippi, where Peter declared, “You are the Messiah.” Enjoy sweeping views from Mount Bental in the Golan Heights. Dinner and overnight: Tiberias

Day 6 – Friday, October 29, 2027

Beit She’an – Jordan River – Dead Sea

Discover the remarkably preserved Roman city of Beit She’an. Pass Ein Harod and travel south through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, one of the world’s oldest cities. Visit Kaser El Yehud

on the Jordan River, with an opportunity for optional baptism. End the day floating in the mineral-rich waters of the Dead Sea. Dinner and overnight: Dead Sea

Day 7 – Saturday, October 30, 2027

Masada – Ein Gedi – Qumran – Jerusalem

Ascend Masada, the dramatic desert fortress of Jewish history. Visit the oasis of Ein Gedi and explore Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Travel up to Jerusalem and enjoy your first breathtaking view of the Holy City from Mount Scopus. Check into your hotel approximately two hours after Shabbat ends. Dinner and overnight: Jerusalem

Day 8 – Sunday, October 31, 2027

Israel Museum – Yad Vashem – Valley of Elah

Visit the Israel Museum, home to the Shrine of the Book and a model of ancient Jerusalem. Reflect at Yad Vashem, Israel’s Holocaust Memorial. Stand in the Valley of Elah, where David chose five smooth stones before confronting Goliath. Dinner and overnight: Jerusalem

Day 9 – Monday, November 1, 2027

Mount of Olives – Garden of Gethsemane – Garden Tomb

Ascend the Mount of Olives for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Walk the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Upper Room, the House of Caiaphas and Church of Peter in Gallicantu. Conclude the day at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb for a meaningful time of reflection. Dinner and overnight: Jerusalem

Day 10 – Tuesday, November 2, 2027

Old City – Temple Mount Area – City of David – Bethlehem

Explore the Old City of Jerusalem, including the area of Mount Moriah and the Pools of Bethesda. Discover the City of David and walk through the Western Wall Tunnels. Travel to Bethlehem, the birthplace of Jesus. Dinner and overnight: Jerusalem

Day 11 – Wednesday, November 3, 2027

Return Home

Transfer to the airport for your flight home, arriving the same day with unforgettable memories and a deeper connection to Scripture.

Terms and Conditions

Passport - A passport is required to board an international flight and travel to Israel. If you do not have a current passport, please make an appointment with the postal service and allow 10 weeks after your appointment to complete the renewal process in the US. Passports must be valid until May 4, 2028 for this tour.

Travel Insurance is HIGHLY recommended for international travel. For best coverage, purchase your travel insurance within 2 weeks of booking your tour. Compare travel insurance options at this website: TravelInsurance.com

Deposits and Payments - A deposit of \$500 is required from each traveler, along with your reservation form, to guarantee your space on the tour. The remaining balance is due in 2 payments.

1. Airfare Payment is due upon ticketing the flight.
2. Final Payment is due August 1, 2027. See Terms and Conditions for late payment penalties.
3. A supplement for single occupancy must be paid in full with the final payment.

Activity Levels

This Tour has an Activity Level Rating of 3-4.

3- Moderate - Moderate tours accommodate guests who are moderately fit, and are comfortable participating in long days of activity. Some physical exertion is expected.

4- Active tours are appropriate for guests who are physically fit, expect a vigorous pace and longer tour days, including walking tours of up to 4 hours without a rest period on the motorcoach.

Health and Mobility Challenges

Tours in Israel include areas that have uneven footing, few handrails, rocky pathways, and some steep climbs. The streets and sites we visit are not wheelchair and walker friendly. Most of our tours include 3-5 miles of walking per day. Guests with mobility challenges or other health issues should make private arrangements to travel with a caregiver who can stay with them if they need to opt out of a tour stop. Bus drivers are allowed breaks, and guests cannot be left alone on the bus if the bus is locked and unattended. If you have health challenges, please consult an Aliyah Tours representative before you put down a deposit on a tour.
