# ITINERARY

## Experience Israel: A Journey Through Scripture & History with Javan Smith, Jr.

**June 2–12, 2027**

### Day 1 | June 2 – Departure

Depart on overnight flights to Tel Aviv. Meals will be served in flight as your journey to the Holy Land begins.

### Day 2 | June 3 – Arrival in Israel

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport and travel to the ancient port city of Jaffa for a walking tour through its historic streets. Continue north along the Mediterranean coast to Netanya. Dinner & overnight: Herzliya / Netanya

### Day 3 | June 4 – Mediterranean Coast to Galilee

Visit the Roman ruins of Caesarea, continue to Mount Carmel, and explore Megiddo overlooking the Jezreel Valley. Travel to Nazareth and stand atop Mount Precipice. Dinner & overnight: Tiberias

### Day 4 | June 5 – Ministry Around the Sea of Galilee

Spend the day tracing the ministry of Jesus around the Sea of Galilee. Visit the Magdala Synagogue, Capernaum, Tabgha, and the region of the Gadarenes. Reflect at the Mount of Beatitudes, with time permitting to explore New Bethsaida. Dinner & overnight: Tiberias

### Day 5 | June 6 – Northern Israel & the Golan Heights

Visit Kibbutz Ginosar to view the ancient Galilee boat, followed by a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Continue to Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, and ascend Mount Bental in the Golan Heights for sweeping views. Dinner & overnight: Tiberias

### Day 6 | June 7 – Jordan Valley & the Dead Sea

Travel through the Jordan Valley to Beit She'an and

Ein Harod, then continue to Jericho. Visit Qasr el-Yehud on the Jordan River, with an optional baptism opportunity. End the day at the Dead Sea. Dinner & overnight: Dead Sea

### Day 7 | June 8 – Desert Strongholds to Jerusalem

Ascend Masada, explore the oasis of Ein Gedi, and visit Qumran, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Continue to Jerusalem via Mount Scopus for a panoramic first view of the Holy City. Dinner & overnight: Jerusalem

### Day 8 | June 9 – Israel's Story: Past & Present

Visit the Israel Museum, including the Shrine of the Book, and Yad Vashem, Israel's Holocaust Memorial. Travel to the Valley of Elah and the stream where David selected stones before facing Goliath. Dinner & overnight: Jerusalem

### Day 9 | June 10 – The Final Days of Jesus

Ascend the Mount of Olives and walk the Palm Sunday Road to the Garden of Gethsemane. Visit the Upper Room, the House of Caiaphas, and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Conclude the day at Golgotha and the Garden Tomb. Dinner & overnight: Jerusalem

### Day 10 | June 11 – Jerusalem: Ancient & Eternal

Explore Jerusalem's Old City, including Mount Moriah, the Temple Mount area, and the Pools of Bethesda. Walk through the City of David, tour the Western Wall Tunnel, and visit Bethlehem. Dinner & overnight: Jerusalem

### Day 11 | June 12 – Departure

Transfer to the airport for your return flight home, carrying memories and insights that will last a lifetime.

### Terms and Conditions

**Passport** - A passport is required to board an international flight and travel to Israel. If you do not have a current passport, please make an appointment with the postal service and allow 10 weeks after your appointment to complete the renewal process in the US. Passports must be valid until December 13, 2027 for this tour.

**Travel Insurance** is HIGHLY recommended for international travel. For best coverage, purchase your travel insurance within 2 weeks of booking your tour. Compare travel insurance options at this website: [TravellInsurance.com](http://TravellInsurance.com)

**Deposits and Payments** - A deposit of \$500 is required from each traveler, along with your reservation form, to guarantee your space on the tour. The remaining balance is due in 2 payments.

1. Airfare Payment is due upon ticketing the flight.
2. Final Payment is due 3/15/27. See Terms and Conditions for late payment penalties.
3. A supplement for single occupancy must be paid in full with the final payment.

### Activity Levels

This Tour has an Activity Level Rating of 3-4.

**3- Moderate** - Moderate tours accommodate guests who are moderately fit, and are comfortable participating in long days of activity. Some physical exertion is expected.

**4- Active tours** are appropriate for guests who are physically fit, expect a vigorous pace and longer tour days, including walking tours of up to 4 hours without a rest period on the motorcoach.

### Health and Mobility Challenges

Tours in Israel include areas that have uneven footing, few handrails, rocky pathways, and some steep climbs. The streets and sites we visit are not wheelchair and walker friendly. Most of our tours include 3-5 miles of walking per day. Guests with mobility challenges or other health issues should make private arrangements to travel with a caregiver who can stay with them if they need to opt out of a tour stop. Bus drivers are allowed breaks, and guests cannot be left alone on the bus if the bus is locked and unattended. If you have health challenges, please consult an Aliyah Tours representative before you put down a deposit on a tour.
