# ITINERARY *(subject to change)*

## **DAY 1** Trans-Atlantic Journey

Depart North America for Tel Aviv, Israel. Relax as meals are served onboard and begin anticipating the adventure of a lifetime as you travel to the Land of the Bible.

## **DAY 2** Welcome to Israel/ Tel Aviv & Jaffa

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport and receive a warm welcome to Israel. Time permitting, enjoy a visit to ancient **Jaffa**, one of the world's oldest port cities. Continue to your hotel in the Herzliya/Netanya area for dinner and a restful overnight stay.



## **DAY 3** Along the Mediterranean to the Galilee

After a full Israeli breakfast, travel north along the Mediterranean coast to Caesarea, the great Roman harbor city. Continue to Mount Carmel, recalling the dramatic encounter of Elijah and the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). Enjoy a traditional Israeli lunch, such as fresh falafel. Visit Megiddo, biblical Armageddon (1 Kings 9:15; Revelation 16). Travel onward to Nazareth before arriving in the Galilee for dinner and overnight by the Sea of Galilee.

## **DAY 4** Ministry of Jesus in the Galilee

Spend the day exploring the heart of Jesus' ministry. Visit the **Mount of Beatitudes**, **Capernaum**, **Tabgha** (site of the Feeding of the 5,000), and the ancient **Magdala Synagogue**. Reflect and worship along the shores of the Sea of Galilee.

## **DAY 5** Golan Heights, Caesarea Philippi

Begin at **Kibbutz Ginosar** to see the ancient "**Jesus Boat**", followed by a memorable boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. Travel north to **Tel Dan** and **Caesarea Philippi**, where Jesus asked His disciples, "*Who do you say that I am?*" (Matthew 16). Continue to **Mount Bental** in the Golan Heights. Dinner and overnight in Tiberias.



## **DAY 6** Jordan Valley to the Dead Sea

Depart Galilee and journey south through the Jordan Valley. Visit **Beit She'an**, **Ein Harod**, and ancient **Jericho**. Enjoy an opportunity for baptism at the **Jordan River**. Continue to the Dead Sea for dinner and overnight.

## **DAY 7** Masada, En Gedi & Ascent to Jerusalem

Ride the cable car up to **Masada**, Herod's fortress and symbol of Jewish resistance. Explore **Ein Gedi**, where David hid from King Saul. Ascend to Jerusalem, viewing the Old City from **Mount Scopus**. Settle in for your stay in Israel's eternal capital.

## **DAY 8** New Jerusalem

Tour modern Jerusalem, including the **Israel Museum**, **Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial**, and the **Valley of Elah**, where David chose stones before facing Goliath. A powerful day of history, remembrance, and faith.

## **DAY 9** Jerusalem-Final Days of Jesus

Stand on the **Mount of Olives**, walk the **Palm Sunday Path**, and visit the **Garden of Gethsemane**. Explore the **Upper Room** and **Caiaphas' House**, reflecting on the final hours before the crucifixion.



## **DAY 10** Old City of Jerusalem

Explore Jerusalem's Old City in depth: **Mount Moriah**, **Pools of Bethesda**, the **City of David**, the **Southern Temple Steps**, **Western Wall**, **Rabbi's Tunnel**, **Jewish Quarter**, and the **Garden Tomb**. Transfer to the airport for your return flight to North America—bringing home unforgettable memories, deeper faith, and countless photos from the Land of the Bible.

### Terms and Conditions

**Passport** - A passport is required to board an international flight and travel to Israel. If you do not have a current passport, please make an appointment with the postal service and allow 10 weeks after your appointment to complete the renewal process in the US. Passports must be valid until May 25, 2027 for this tour.

**Travel Insurance** is HIGHLY recommended for international travel. For best coverage, purchase your travel insurance within 2 weeks of booking your tour. Compare travel insurance options at this website: [TravellInsurance.com](http://TravellInsurance.com)

**Deposits and Payments** - A deposit of \$500 is required from each traveler, along with your reservation form, to guarantee your space on the tour. The remaining balance is due in 2 payments.

1. Airfare Payment is due upon ticketing the flight.
2. Final Payment is due 9/1/26. See Terms and Conditions for late payment penalties.
3. A supplement for single occupancy must be paid in full with the final payment.

### Activity Levels

This Tour has an Activity Level Rating of 3-4.

**3- Moderate** - Moderate tours accommodate guests who are moderately fit, and are comfortable participating in long days of activity. Some physical exertion is expected.

**4- Active tours** are appropriate for guests who are physically fit, expect a vigorous pace and longer tour days, including walking tours of up to 4 hours without a rest period on the motorcoach.

### Health and Mobility Challenges

Tours in Israel include areas that have uneven footing, few handrails, rocky pathways, and some steep climbs. The streets and sites we visit are not wheelchair and walker friendly. Most of our tours include 3-5 miles of walking per day. Guests with mobility challenges or other health issues should make private arrangements to travel with a caregiver who can stay with them if they need to opt out of a tour stop. Bus drivers are allowed breaks, and guests cannot be left alone on the bus if the bus is locked and unattended. If you have health challenges, please consult an Aliyah Tours representative before you put down a deposit on a tour.
